## Minimum **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS** HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA **RESOLUTION 2025 -089** WHEREAS, substance misuse is a major societal problem throughout the country; and WHEREAS, The National Association of Drug Court Professionals now known as AllRise has proclaimed May as NATIONAL TREATMENT COURT MONTH; and WHEREAS, the first drug court was established in Miami, Florida, in 1989 and has served as model for 183 problem-solving court currently operational in Florida and more than 4,000 problem-solving courts currently operating throughout the United States; and WHEREAS, Hernando County Treatment Courts, from inception on October 1, 2001, have provided services and made substance use treatment available to three hundred and twenty-four (324) adult citizens of Hernando County; and WHEREAS, Treatment Courts provides the focus and leadership for community-wide, anti-drug systems, bringing together criminal justice, treatment programs, education, and other community partners in the fight against substance use and criminality; and WHEREAS, Treatment Court programs combine intensive judicial supervision, mandatory substance use treatment, accountability, drug testing and escalating sanctions and incentives to break the cycle of substance use disorders and its associated crimes. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:** SECTION 1.
