A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, MODIFYING THE ONCE-A-WEEK WATERING RESTRICTION FOR ESTABLISHED LAWNS LANDSCAPING TO A TWICE-A-WEEK RESTRICTION FOR A PERIOD OF 180 DAYS; FINDING THAT PRESENT WATER **SUPPLY** CONDITIONS WARRANT MODIFICATION: PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SUPERSEDE PRIOR ACTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners, finding that present water supply conditions warrant, desires to modify the once-a-week watering restriction for established lawns and landscaping to a twice-a-week restriction for a period of One Hundred and Eighty (180) days from the adoption hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:

- **SECTION 1.** The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
- **SECTION 2.** Based upon a finding that present water supply conditions warrant and that there are no outstanding rules, regulations or orders of the Southwest Florida Water Management District which are inconsistent with the action described in this Resolution, the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") hereby modifies the once-a-week watering restriction for established lawns and landscaping to a twice-a-week restriction in accordance with Sec. 28-503(c)(2) of the Hernando County Code of Ordinances, as amended this date.
- **SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall sunset on <u>July 13, 2012</u> (One Hundred and Eighty Days from the adoption hereof).
- **SECTION 4.** In the event of any conflict between this Resolution and any prior resolution or actions of the Board, this Resolution shall supersede and control.
- **SECTION 5.** If any section or part of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
