THREE AGREEMENTS

- INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BROOKSVILLE AND HERNANDO COUNTY REGARDING CONSOLIDATION OF FIRE RESCUE SERVICES
- INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES
 CAPITAL FACILITY IMPACT FEE JOINT PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION
- INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR LEASE OF FIRE STATION

CONSOLIDATION

- BEGINS OCTOBER 1, 2025. CONTINUES UNTIL CANCELLED.
- COUNTY TO PROVIDE FIRE SUPPRESSION, FIRE PREVENTION, RESCUE, AND RELATED EMERGENCY SERVICES IN CITY LIMITS.
- ALL FIREFIGHTER PERSONNEL OFFERED POSITIONS
 - ABILITY TO GO TO MEDIC SCHOOL TO MEET QUALIFICATIONS AND TEST FOR PROMOTION TO PREVIOUS POSITION IN THE CITY OF BROOKSVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT.
 - TENURE, YEARS OF SERVICE, ACCRUED LEAVE, AND SENIORITY MAINTAINED WITH COUNTY POLICIES.
- COMPENSATION TO HERNANDO COUNTY FOR FY 2026 WILL BE \$1,478,341.89 PAYABLE IN 12 EQUAL MONTHLY INSTALLMENTS.

CONSOLIDATION

- FIRE MSBU: FY 2027 LEVIED TO ALL PROPERTY OWNERS IN CITY OF BROOKSVILLE.
- BROOKSVILLE NAME OF FIRE STATION AND FIRE ENGINE AT STATION 10.
- CITY FIRE PENSION LIABILITY RESPONSIBILITY OF CITY OF BROOKSVILLE.
- COUNTY PURCHASE CITY FIRE ENGINE AND BRUSH TRUCK.
- COUNTY RESPONSIBLE FOR FIRE INSPECTIONS IN CITY OF BROOKSVILLE.

IMPACT FEES

- FY 26: CITY COLLECTS IMPACT FEES AND TRANSFERS TO THE COUNTY AT THE CITY APPROVED RATE UNTIL SEPT. 30, 2026.
- COUNTY UPDATES IMPACT FEE STUDY BY MAY 1, 2026 TO INCLUDE CITY OF BROOKSVILLE, INCLUDING UPDATING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.
- AFTER APPROVED NEW RATE: CITY COLLECTS IMPACT FEES AT NEW RATE AND TRANSFERS TO THE COUNTY.

LEASE AGREEMENT

- COHABITATION AGREEMENT CANCELLED.
- THE COST WILL BE \$1.00 FOR FY 2026, AFTER WHICH TIME IT WILL BE \$12.00 PER SQUARE FOOT FOR A
 TOTAL ANNUAL RENT OF \$145,896.00.
- CITY RESPONSIBLE FOR MAJOR REPAIRS:
 - ROOF, MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT (A/C), VENT HOOD, GENERATOR, STRUCTURAL
- COUNTY RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL UTILITIES, MINOR REPAIRS
- INSURANCE: COUNTY MAINTAIN PROPERTY AND LIABILITY INSURANCE




