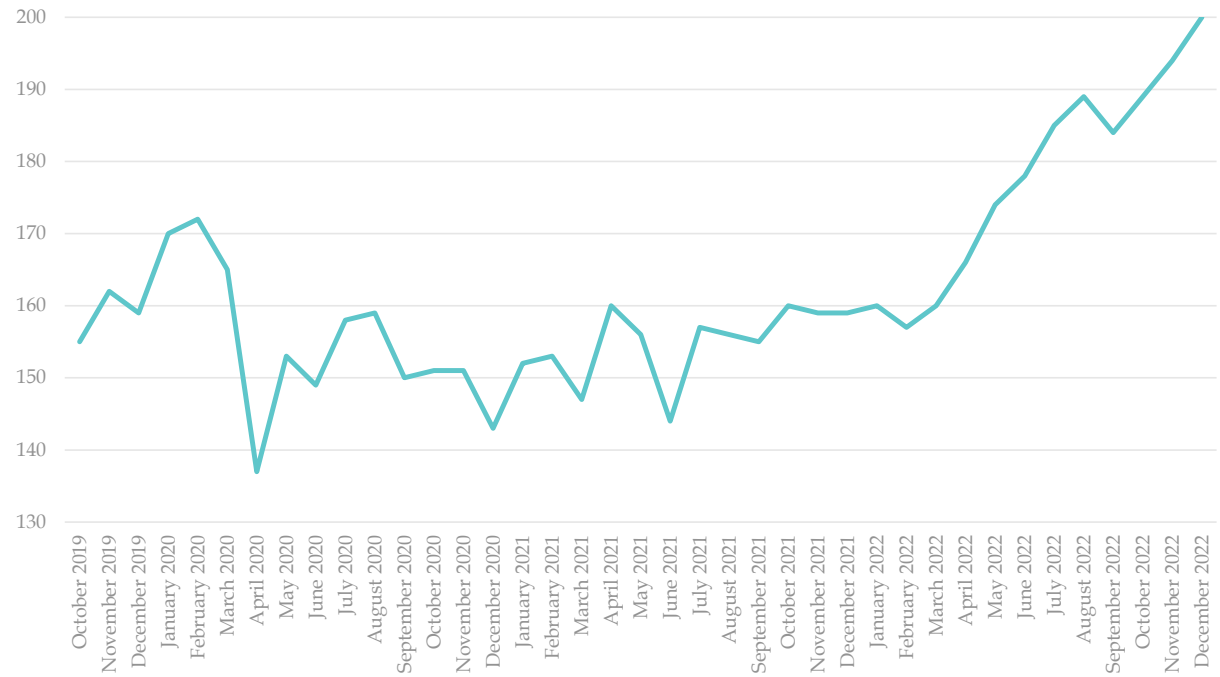


Vanpool Numbers

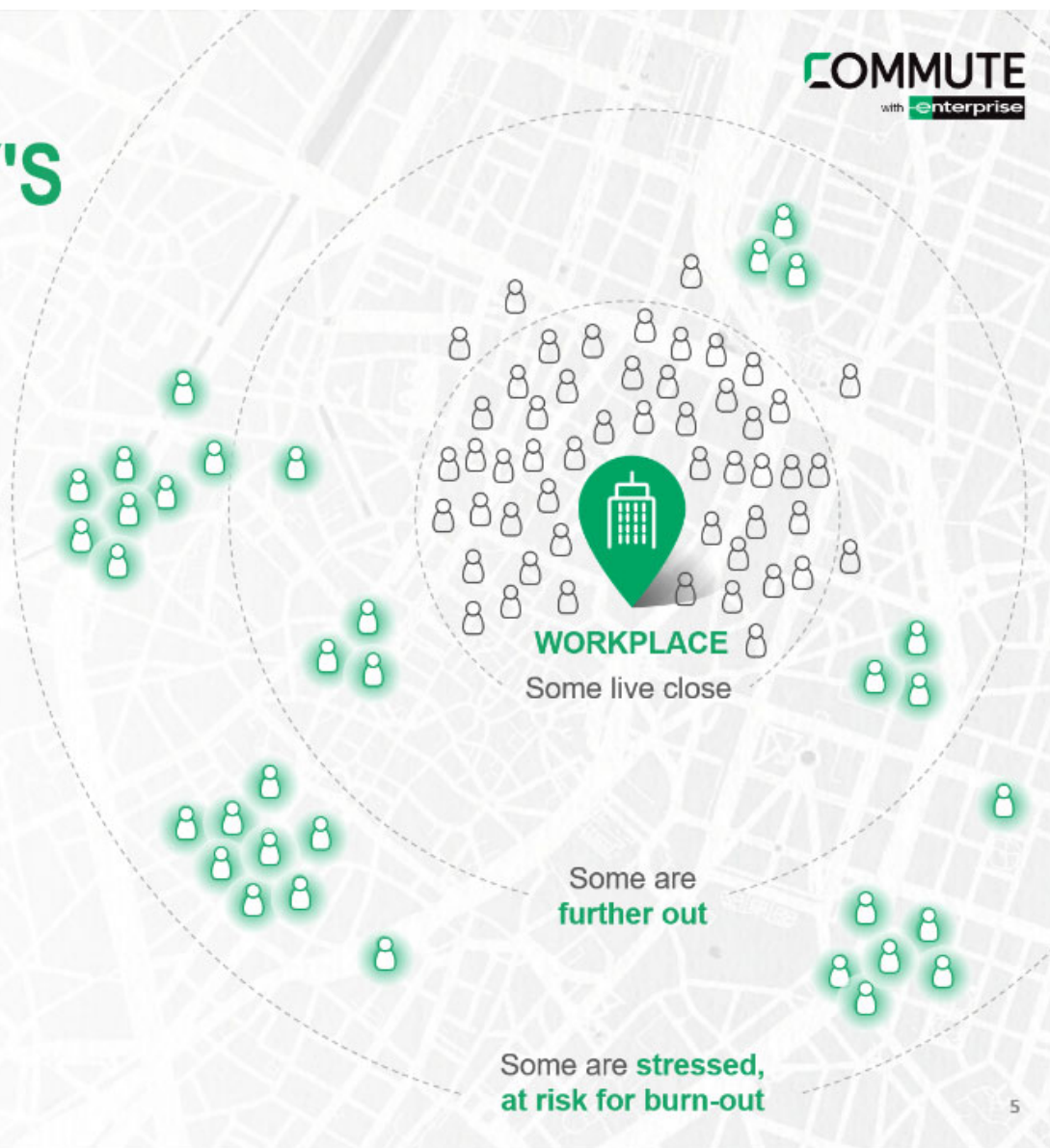
Map your employees based on proximity to the worksite, focusing on the 1/3 who live further out

live close to work

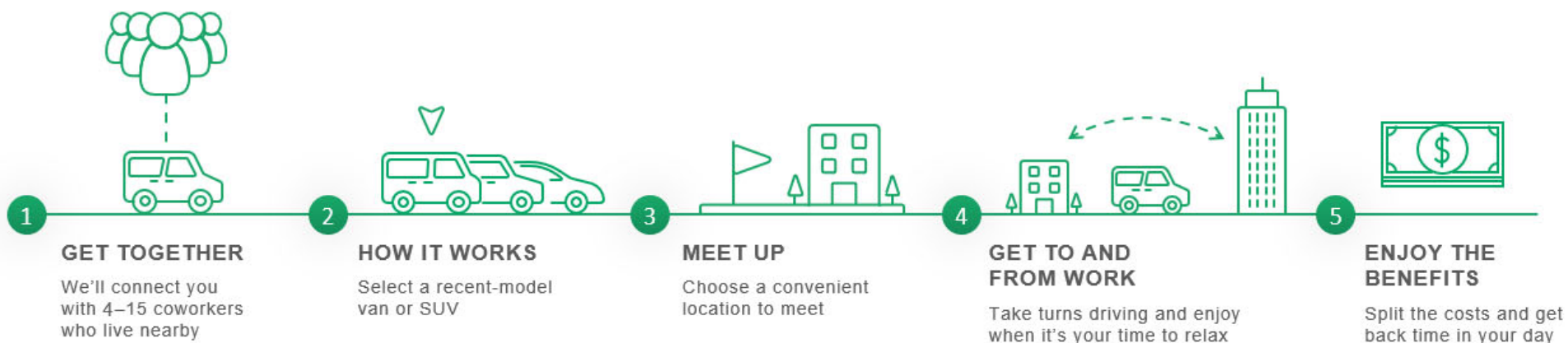

Emergency Ride Home

- Commute to class/work at least two times a week by means other than driving alone
- TBARTA reimburses the cost of a taxi, Uber, or Lyft to \$100 per occurrence
- Reimbursements can be claimed up to 6 times in a calendar year
