Chapter 26 – Subdivision Regulations, Article III – Design Standards

Sec. 26-52. - Sidewalks.









- (a) Sidewalks shall be constructed on all internal, and adjoining, streets in conjunction with all new subdivisions.
- (b) Sidewalks shall be constructed in conjunction with the installation of all required subdivision improvements along common areas and adjoining streets. Sidewalks shall be constructed as a condition of site development for the length of the site frontage along all streets for individual lots within the subdivision.
- (c) All sidewalks shall be designed and constructed in accordance with the requirements of the Florida Accessibility Code and Hernando County Facilities Design Guidelines.

Appendix A – Zoning, Article III – Specific Regulations, Section 3 – Specific Use Regulations

P. Sidewalks.

- Sidewalks shall be constructed for the length of the site frontage along all adjoining roadways in conjunction with all new construction under the following conditions:
 - (a) The site is located along a county designated arterial or collector street;
 - (b) The site is adjacent to properties with existing sidewalks; or
 - (c) The site is within two (2) miles of a public school.
- All sidewalks shall be designed and constructed in accordance with the requirements of the Florida Accessibility Code and Hernando County Facilities Design Guidelines.
- 3. The county engineer may permit the waiver of sidewalk construction where one (1) or more of the following conditions exist:
 - (a) The existing street or right-of-way is unimproved.
 - (b) The sidewalk cannot be constructed due to existing natural, environmental, topographic or hazardous conditions.
 - (c) The property is located in an area where sidewalks do not exist, new sidewalks are not projected nor planned for, and no abutting or connecting sidewalks exist.
 - (d) The county engineer may require a contribution to the county sidewalk improvement fund as a condition of granting the waiver.
