PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

The Adopt-A-Park Program allows participants to contribute toward the effort to help control litter and enhance park appearance by engaging in clean-up activities.

Participants are advised that working in public parks does have potential risks associated with clean-up activities to include, but are not limited to, potentially dangerous items such as discarded drug paraphernalia, needles, sharp objects, trash, and other items that require appropriate hand protection for safe disposal. Other potential risks include potential indigenous animals and reptiles. Each participant is further advised that the risk of harm is present even if all safety precautions are followed.

Each participant is advised by the Volunteer Organization about safety rules/guidelines and regulations while performing this activity and agrees to exercise due care and caution at all times while performing litter clean-up and other program activities.

Participants are required to wear the appropriate protective clothing during program activities. A list of requirements is included in the packet provided to the Volunteer Organization.

PARTICIPANTS ARE ADVISED THAT THE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS DESCRIBED ABOVE DO NOT GUARANTEE THEIR SAFETY WHILE A PARTICIPANT IN THIS PROGRAM.

Note: The Volunteer Organization Leader must bring a copy of this form to the activity site in case of accident or injury. In addition, the Volunteer Organization Leader will maintain copies for their records.
