My name is Brinda Whiteside. I am 76 years old, and a widow. I have lived at 6053 Newmark St. for twenty three years, since my husband died. In my thirty five years of nursing the majority of that time was spent working with Metro, State or Federal government. Now that I am retired and widowed and too old to move, I have to fight once again for my home. I have no living blood relatives. I live from paycheck to paycheck, like most people my age today.

When we ask why they are so determined to build on this site, rather than across the road, they stated that property cost more money. Well that property does not affect peoples homes and day to days lives. They could also go south one block, in front of Publix. Between Springhill St. and Applegate. Twenty three years ago we were told this strip of wooded area was protected land and would not be rezoned. This is why people no longer trust the government. This used to be a beautiful place to live. You could walk with your neighbor, ride your bike and raise your children in a safe place. If you vote to rezone this land you are taking that from us.
