Good Morning to the ^{Commissioners} Board and representative(s) of Downtown Development Partners, LLC.

- Intro: Resident of Regency Oaks Subdivision / Rt. 19 and Breakwater Blvd.
 - File #: **H-22-28**
 - Issue: ^{Here to oppose} The rezoning from single home to commercial property proximity
1. My family and many home owners are 2nd generation residents of Regency Oaks. The community appealed to my parents because of its' secluded location without being a gated community, and they built our home in 1996.
 2. We have serious concerns for future of the community, with the plan to rezone, ~~without the consent or concerns of the tax-paying and voting residents of Regency Oaks,~~ from single family to commercial property.
 3. Commercial entities have already encroached on the community of Regency Oaks, which you are probably aware due to the proximity of your offices to our community, ~~to the point of impacting quality of life and safety issues.~~
issues.
 4. Areas of concern include: 1. Heightened traffic on Breakwater, and Frontage, which is the cross street for business access. 2. The woods act as a sound barrier, reducing traffic noise and visibility from Rt.19, and (3) The commercial properties would be less than a football field away. The lighting needed to cover the stores and parking 228 parking space area would intrude on homes and possibly cause sleeping issues for many residents.

5. Entering Regency Oaks has become a game of chance as drivers crossing Frontage often don't always acknowledge the Stop signs. Breakwater to Lakewood Plaza is congested daily by patrons of Starbucks blocking one of the two lanes on Frontage. There have also been a number of serious accidents, with fatalities, at the Commercial Way and Breakwater intersection.
6. Commercial business coming into the community, in addition to increasing residential access congestion, will introduce more non-residents into the sub-division, introducing a heightened security issue. We would have no control over the type of businesses or clientele that would patronize the building so close to our homes. There is only one way in and one way out, and it is almost guaranteed that people will enter the community looking for a rear exit because they missed the No Exit sign.
7. An additional access road was added on Frontage near the Dollar Tree and the gas station BUT, as Regency Oaks is on the southbound side, drivers needing to go north often exit onto Breakwater in order to make a left onto Rt.19 rather than chance exiting the Merit station and swinging into the far left lane to make a u-turn.
8. Our community has a large number of senior and recreational walkers, bike riders and dog-walkers and teens that need our community to remain pedestrian friendly. In addition, added traffic would, undoubtedly, have an effect on school bus and emergency vehicle access, which is important due to the large number of older residents.
9. This re-zoning will also compromise our **property value**. (I'm aware that you are contractor/builders, but *PLEASE* don't say it wouldn't . Buyers are more inclined to purchase a home they can access with the least amount of difficulty.)

(*Imagine a Walmart moving into **your** quiet backyard or neighborhood and **you** suddenly having to jockey with miscellaneous drivers just to get into your street or community safely.)

10. There are a number of empty business buildings, and vacant properties available with extensive acreage that could be utilized without encroaching on residential communities.

11. Suggested locations that would not impact homeowners and offer safer entrance and exit points are, for example:

- a. Kass Circle, near St. Vincent DePaul Thrift Store which had 2 access points from Spring Hill Dr. and there is property for sale on both sides of the street.
- b. Property south of the Walgreens on Lake in the Woods Dr. and Rt. 19, to Tarken (?) and after Pizza Hut, all the way to the Shell gas station.
- c. Property on the north side of Rt. 19 between Spring Hill Dr. and Mc Donalds.
- d. Property north of Cortez/Rt. 50 beyond Hardee's on either side of Rt. 19, just to name a few.

IN CONCLUSION , , ,

We, the residents of Regency Oaks, are feeling squeezed and potentially trapped, so we implore the Downtown Development Partners and Zoning board members who are considering this re-zoning to PLEASE ... reconsider the impact this decision will have on the lives and wellbeing of the residents of Regency Oaks, and to consider a less congested location that would offer the Downtown Development Partners the acreage, access, visibility and safety desired for their own customer appeal and financial success.

Many who walk and ride the streets feel very safe even as there are no sidewalks, they know the residents who drive in or out will yield to them as they walk on the curbs.

The number of Storage facilities built in Hernando County indicates growth in the County as many relocate here, Regency Oaks has benefitted from this growth as we welcome new residents. This has resulted in an increase of children who walk, ride, and play in the area. With no sidewalks and awaiting their pickup intersections for the school buses, with increased traffic they will be in great danger.

Regency Oaks has only one entrance IN and OUT, and it would be a disaster if someone gets injured by a car and we must wait until the road clears after an investigation is completed, what must we do to get in or out to run an errand?

There are many seniors who don't drive and very often will use shopping carts to bring their purchases home and leave them by the clubhouse, or further into Breakwater Blvd. some consideration must be given to them.

Every day brings a flow of delivery vehicles into Regency Oaks, Fedex, Amazon, UPS, The Postal Service, Door dash, Spectrum, Contractors, and Repairmen, most recently Kroeger has been making deliveries, also the Garbage trucks making their scheduled pickups. What will happen if heavy duty construction equipment moves on the site?

The proximity of many resources necessary for survival, stores, banks, restaurants, hardware stores, hospitals and medical facilities attracted us.

With the proposed re-zoning, which will bring additional traffic, the loss of foliage by removing trees which provides the needed air quality for our survival, and the impact on homes and the environment, will be disastrous to all who live in Regency Oaks.

My name is Anne O'Dell and I live at 5038 Heavenly Court in Regency Oaks. Thank you for the opportunity to comment. Please include my comments in the record of this meeting.

When my father, a World War II veteran, had our family home built in Regency Oaks in 1990, they were moving into a new development that was primarily occupied by retirees. There were one and two cars per home.

In 1990 the population of Spring Hill was about 31,000.

Since many of the Greatest Generation have now passed, Regency Oaks has "turned over", in real estate parlance. There are now many families with young children living in our midst. There are now three, four, even five cars per home. They are parked on the grass and on the street. There are more trips in and out of Breakwater Blvd due to this.

The 2020 Census puts the population of Spring Hill at 113,568!

My concern is for the safety of our residents. Adding two commercial buildings, 228 parking spaces, and the associated traffic this will generate will add tremendous risk to the families of Regency Oaks who must use Breakwater Blvd to travel to and from their homes. The existing traffic from the businesses on Frontage Road is already difficult to negotiate.

At least one family has already lost their lives at the intersection of Breakwater and Commercial Way.

I'm a motorcyclist. There are a couple dozen of us in Regency Oaks. Increased traffic is especially risky for us.

We don't want a second entrance as that will cause thru traffic and more serious issues for our neighborhood.

What Spring Hill needs is more single family units - not more restaurants, and not more commercial space, when much of the commercial space that exists nearby sits vacant.

I urge this Commission to reject Downtown Development Partners' proposed commercial complex, and keep the single family zoning. It will generate far less traffic.

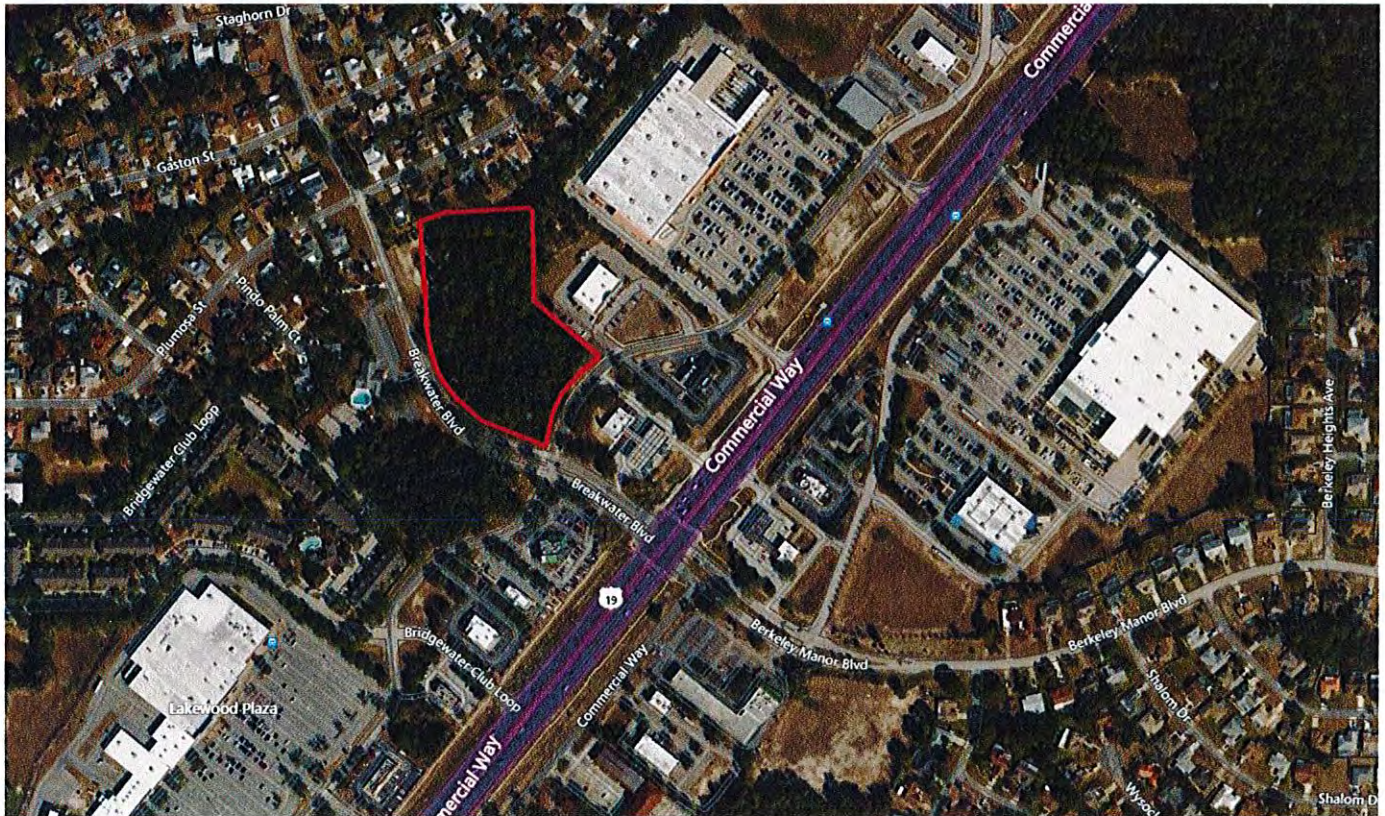

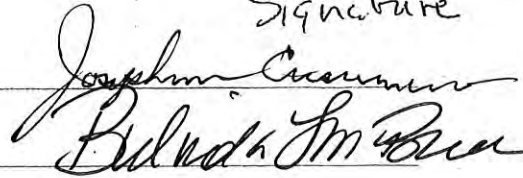
