RE: Out of County Waste Coming to Hernando County Landfill

Executive Order 24-214 from the Governor of the State of Florida dated October 5, 2024, states in section 4. C. 1.

C. In accordance with section 252.38(3) Florida Statutes, each political subdivision within the State of Florida may waive the procedures and formalities otherwise required of the political subdivision by law pertaining to:

- 1) Performance of public work and taking whatever prudent action necessary to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the community;

Due to the impact of Hurricane Milton, and there has not been enough time for the debris from Hurricane Helene to be removed. County Administrator Jeffrey Rogers on a temporary bases will allow Citrus County residents to use the Hernando County landfill located at 14450 Landfill Road, Brooksville, FL 34614 to remove debris before the impacts of Hurricane Milton occur this week. This allowance shall expire upon landfall of Hurricane Milton.
