TITLE

Request to Submit Application for Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration Grants to Expand Substance Abuse Treatment Capacity in Adult and Family Drug Courts

BRIEF OVERVIEW

Description/Background:

This is a five-year grant that would allow expansion and enhancement of treatment services for many of our problem-solving courts (Drug Courts, Veterans Treatment Court, Mental Health Court). This funding opportunity would cover treatment provided by BayCare and additional expenses related to expansion needs.

Budget Impact:

Up to \$400,000 a year for 5 years. No local match is required.

The application is still in the early stages of writing at this time. Due to the short application time period (application is due 1/4/19), it is requested the Board authorize the Courts to submit the application for funding.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

No financial impact at this time. If awarded the grant, there will be an increase in revenue to the grant department. There is not a required grant match.

LEGAL NOTE

The Board is authorized to act on this matter pursuant to Chapter 125, Florida Statutes.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the Board approve the request to submit the application for the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Grant to Expand Substance Abuse Treatment Capacity in Adult and Family Drug Courts and authorize the County Administrator to submit the grant application on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners. If the grant is awarded, documentation will be presented to the Board for approval and acceptance. There is no required local match.
