FWC Agreement No. 18075, Amendment 4

This Amendment to Agreement No. 18075, referred to as the Amended Agreement, is entered into by and between the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, whose address is 620 South Meridian Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1600, hereafter “Commission” or “FWC,” and Hernando County Board of County Commissioners, 59-1155275, whose address is 15470 Flight Path Drive, Brooksville, Florida, 34604, hereinafter “Recipient,” collectively, “Parties”.

## **CHANGES TO THE CONTRACT**

In consideration of the mutual benefits set forth herein and, in the Amended Agreement, the parties agree to amend the Amended Agreement as follows, which amendments shall govern to the exclusion of any provision of the Amended Agreement to the contrary:

**Section 3, Agreement Period, Part A, Agreement Period and Commission’s Limited Obligation to Pay** of the Amended Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

**A. Agreement Period and Commission’s Limited Obligation to Pay.** This Agreement is made pursuant to a grant award and shall be effective upon execution by the last Party to sign and shall remain in effect through 03/31/2025. However, as authorized by Rule 68-1.003, F.A.C., referenced grant programs may execute Agreements with a retroactive start date of no more than sixty (60) days, provided that approval is granted from the Executive Director or his/her designee and that it is in the best interest of the Commission and State to do so. For this agreement, the retroactive start date was not approved. The Commission’s Grant Manager shall confirm the specific start date of the Agreement by written notice to the Grantee. The Grantee shall not be eligible for reimbursement or compensation for grant activities performed prior to the start date of this Agreement nor after the end date of the Agreement. For this agreement, pre-award costs are not eligible for reimbursement. If necessary, by mutual agreement as evidenced in writing and lawfully executed by the Parties, an Amendment to this Agreement may be executed to lengthen the Agreement period.



**Section 1, Project Description, Subsection D, Term of the Agreement** of Attachment A, Scope of Work of the Amended Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:


**D. Term of Agreement:** The term of the Agreement shall begin upon execution and end on March 31, 2025. Prior to the end of the term, the Hamilton County Board of County Commissioners (Grantee) shall complete the tasks and provide the deliverables described in this Scope of Work. **All activities must be completed by March 31, 2025.**
