The initiative is to -rehabilitate an existing structure on Mariner Blvd Education Center site to update a Culinary commercial kitchen for clients, employees and public. Also, an ADA indoor recreation room will be updated as well as an outdoor area in need of updates to provide shaded areas for life enrichment through physical fitness for clients unable to participate in outdoor activities due to physical limitations caused by outside environmental and weather related concerns.

1. Objective Activities:

This initiative has two goals: (1) to update a commercial kitchen to allow for a Café operated by adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities served by The Arc Nature Coast, and (2) to update an ADA-compliant indoor recreation room and outdoor area to support fitness, enrichment, and overall well-being.

2. Service to be Provided:

The Café will offer job skills training in food prep, customer service, money handling, and sanitation. It will be open to the public, fostering inclusion and community engagement. The recreation areas will host seated exercise, yoga, adaptive sports, music, games, and more—accessible to all, regardless of physical limitations or weather conditions.

3. End Product Expected:

Clients will gain vocational skills and increased access to employment. The Café will promote public awareness and inclusion. The recreation center will improve physical health, social interaction, and emotional well-being for participants.

This is an endeavor we have long wanted to expand upon to further educate our clients and engage them more inclusively with the surrounding community members all while enhancing their vocational and recreational opportunities and skills






