



WITHLACOOCHEE RIVER AT TRILBY (US 301)







adjacent low-lying areas






Topographic Map

Yellow, green areas are lower)*


- **10/14:** River at 301 rose above 65.5 feet and floodwaters began entering Lakes Geneva, Elizabeth and Francis
- **10/23:** Flooded lakes peaked at 67.4 feet
- **10/28:** County and State began pumping water back to the Withlacoochee River


FEMA 1% Annual Chance Flood Hazard Zone
