RESOLUTION 2025-179

**WHEREAS**, in 2025, there are more than 4 million women with a history of breast cancer in the United States, including women currently being treated and women who have finished treatment; and

**WHEREAS**, besides skin cancers, breast cancer is the most common type of cancer among women in the United States. It is estimated that 316,950 new cases of invasive breast cancer will be diagnosed in women in the United States in 2025 and nearly 42,680 women are expected to die from the disease this year; and

**WHEREAS**, it is estimated that 2,800 new cases of invasive breast cancer will be diagnosed in men in 2025 and approximately 530 men will die from breast cancer this year; and

**WHEREAS**, thanks to largely stable incident rates, improved treatment, as well as earlier detection through screening and increased awareness, a woman's risk of dying from breast cancer dropped 44% between 1989 and 2017, translating into more than 518,000 breast cancer deaths avoided during that time; and

**WHEREAS**, self-breast examination and mammography are among the most effective and widely available methods of early detection of breast cancer, and as mammography screening rates have increased, more cases of breast cancer have been found at earlier stages, when the chances of survival are highest; and

**WHEREAS**, during **BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH**, we recognize all those who know the anguish of breast cancer and redouble our efforts to improve care and bring awareness to this disease; and

**WHEREAS**, as we honor those lost to breast cancer, let us join with loved ones who celebrate their memory and the patients who battle this disease every day, as well as our Nation's advocates, medical researchers, and health care providers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The Board of County Commissioners hereby proclaim October 2025 as **BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH** in Hernando County.






