Subject: Proposed 2023 Five-Year Water Resource Development Work Program

Dear Governor DeSantis:

Pursuant to subsection 373.536(6)(a)(4), Florida Statutes, each water management district is required to furnish a five-year water resource development work program within 30 days after the adoption of the final budget. The Southwest Florida Water Management District (District) approved its proposed 2023 Five-Year Water Resource Development Work Program at its Governing Board meeting held on September 20, 2022 and adopted its fiscal year 2022-2023 budget at a public hearing held on September 20, 2022.

Enclosed please find the District's proposed 2023 Five-Year Water Resource Development Work Program. After receiving comments from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), the District will respond to the evaluation within 45 days. Any revisions prompted by DEP's evaluation will be incorporated into the final report that will be included as part of the District's Consolidated Annual Report. The Consolidated Annual Report is due no later than March 1, 2023, pursuant to subsection 373.036(7), Florida Statutes.
