LOCATION: Northwest corner of Spring Hill Drive and the Suncoast Parkway and east side of

Barclay Avenue, approximately 1,500' north of Spring Hill Drive

FINDINGS

OF FACT: ALL of the facts and conditions set forth in the County's staff memoranda and

presented to the BOCC in connection with the public hearing in this matter are incorporated herein by reference and made a material part of this Resolution as integral to the BOCC's Action. The BOCC finds that the testimony and record

supporting <u>APPROVAL</u> of the request to be credible and to constitute competent substantial evidence. In further support thereof, the BOCC makes the following specific findings of fact:

1. The proposed request is consistent with the County's adopted Comprehensive Plan and is compatible with the surrounding land uses.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The BOCC is authorized to act on this matter pursuant to Chapters 125 and 163, *Florida Statutes*. Accordingly, after public hearing and testimony, being fully advised in the record, and based upon competent substantial evidence, the BOCC makes the following specific conclusions of law:

1. The proposed request is consistent with the County's adopted Comprehensive Plan and is compatible with the surrounding land uses.

ACTION:

After notice and public hearing, based upon the record in this matter and ALL of the findings of fact and conclusions of law above, the BOCC hereby <u>APPROVES</u> the request to Establish a Master Plan on Property Zoned PDP(GC)/Planned Development Project (General Commercial) and a Rezoning from PDP(GC)/Planned Development Project (General Commercial) to CPDP/Combined Planned Development Project to include General Commercial with a specific C-2 use for Mini-Warehouses, Multifamily, an Adult Congregate Care Living Facility and Deviations, as set forth in the BOCC Action, which is incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof. Any requests, uses, variances or exceptions that were requested in connection with this rezoning application but not specifically approved herein are hereby deemed <u>DENIED</u>.
