DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Florida Senate Bill 552 (SB 552) was passed in July of 2016 establishing Florida Springs and Aquifer Protection Act. The Bill was created to protect Florida's water and natural resources and the policies therein were aimed to preserve and restore the state's resources for current and future use. The policy further aimed to protect and restore flows and water quality in the state's Outstanding Florida Springs (OFS). Hernando County has two identified OFS; Weeki Wachee and Chassahowitzka. Under these laws, local governments are required to address Septic Tank Remediation in their comprehensive plan.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS:

To bring consistency with State Law as it pertains to Septic Tank Remediation in Hernando County, staff is proposing corresponding changes to the Goals, Objectives and Strategies of the Chapter 6 Utilities Element of the 2040 Comprehensive Plan. The proposed changes are consistent with the plans and programs of the Hernando County Utilities Department and incorporating HCUD plan name by reference.

Specific Text Amendments:

Strategy 6.02E(5): Hernando County adopts by reference Wastewater Treatment Feasibility Analysis Report. The County shall review and update the work plan as needed, in accordance with Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) requirements.
