SECTION 2. The Board of County Commissioners approves the unsolicited offer by the Hernando County Grower's Association, Inc., for the above-described property. In the event the property is not used or ceases to be used for the purpose stated herein, the property shall revert to Hernando County which shall thereafter have the right to re-enter and repossess the property.
