

We attended the meeting, and are writing this letter because we want it noted that we are absolutely opposed to this change in zoning. This property should remain residential.

We have been at our address for almost 30 years. We chose this area for our home because it was in and out of the way of commercial areas and traffic. There is already too much traffic on Linden Drive and County Line Road. There is also no doubt, if this proposal is approved it would decrease the value of our home.

When going out onto County Line Road off of Linden Drive, going one mile east and one mile west there are already warehouses (storage units). We cannot complain about those because they are built and being built on commercial property, but we can ask please, keep our residential properties residential.

We understand progress, but again we ask you to please consider the homeowners when making your decisions. Please do not consider allowing commercial into the residential neighborhood streets.
