

State Housing Initiatives Partnership Program Annual Report 2021/2022



Purpose of the SHIP Program?

- To meet the housing needs of the very low-, low- and moderate-income households
- To expand production of and to preserve affordable housing; and
- To further the housing element of the local government comprehensive plan specific to affordable housing



Set Aside Requirements of the SHIP Program

- 65% of funding directed to homeownership
- 75% of funding directed to construction activities
- 20% of funding must serve persons with special needs
- 30% of funding must be reserved for verylow-income persons

2021/2022 Results

Strategy	Households Served	Income Level	Total Funds Expended

Down Payment Assistance

The Hernando County Purchase Assistance program provides income-qualified individuals/families with down payment, closing costs and renovation assistance. Renovation assistance may be used to bring the home up to current building code and/or health codes standards and/or expand the living area of the home.

Emergency Repair


The Hernando County Emergency Repair program provides income-qualified individuals/families to make needed repairs on homestead property for families facing immediate emergencies to the home including roof replacement, windows, electrical hazards, septic, plumbing, non-functioning HVAC, and handicap accessibility.

Owner-Occupied Rehab

The Hernando County owner-occupied rehab program allows for more extensive and substantive repair cost to individual units to correct housing and building code violations, provide cost effective energy conserving features, make the dwelling accessible to handicapped and elderly occupants, correct health and/or safety violations that may be present.


