Narrative

This information report is in reference to a large Sportfish type vessel grounded in the area of Chassahowitzka Bay, near the Citrus/Hernando County line.

On 05/04/2025, I was performing marine patrol in the area of Chassahowitzka Bay when I observed a large vessel which appeared to be aground in the area of Bird Island. Upon inspecting the situation further, the vessel was found to be stuck in a very shallow area just on the northwest side of Bird Island, GPS- 28 40.502'N 82 41.163'W. When observing the vessel, on the transom it was labeled "Eighty" and underneath was "St. Petersburg, FL." A vessel registration decal was observed on the stern side window. This had the registration numbers of FL1693LJ along with decal #08029041. The expiration date of the decal is 06/2025. A teletype query of this vessel revealed it is a 46' long Bertram Yachts Sportfish type vessel built in 1987. It is currently registered to Richard Zielinski with an address of 218 Lewis Blvd. SE, Saint Petersburg, FL. 33705 and is not reported as stolen. Upon a DAVID search of Richard it shows

him having an address of 328 52nd Street West, Palmetto, FL. 34221. The hull number for this vessel is BERP0978K687.

Further inspection revealed the condition of the vessel to be poor. The transom scuppers were taped up with crab trap buoys and all hull fittings appear to be taped up as well, possibly in an attempt to keep water out of the hull. The rear door leading into the galley was open and the contents inside the vessel appeared to be scattered throughout. Upon making sure nobody was aboard needing help, I observed the engine covers to be off and in different stages of possible repair. The port side windows were broken allowing rain to come inside as the blinds were stained. This vessel has two upper stations and upon inspecting them all of the electronics appear to have been removed from the stations. Nobody was found inside the vessel needing help and no obvious signs of a crime were observed while inspecting it.

Photographs were taken of the vessel's condition and later uploaded to this case.

Contact was made with Florida Fish and Wildlife who were able to provide me a phone number of 907-399-2092. I attempted contact with Richard on this number but had no success.

At this time, further attempts will be made to contact the registered owner. I request this case be placed in my queue for further investigation/follow up.

On 05/30/2025, I once again made contact with Richard. I explained to Richard that this information needed to be sent as soon as possible, as this is an open investigation. He apologized for the inconvenience and advised that he would send it as soon as possible.

Also on 05/30/2025, contact was made with Coast Guard Petty Officer Nichole Forester-Bennett. Nichole advised that she was attempting to contact me in reference to this vessel. She received information from a "good Samaritan" that observed this same vessel to be "free floating" near Bird Island, possibly due to the high tides we have recently experienced in the area. She further explained that the citizen pulled the vessel to the Chassahowitzka Channel and attached it to channel marker 14. At this time, the current status of the vessel is unknown, but I will be following up in the near future to make sure this is correct. I will also be in contact with Richard for the correspondence.

On 05/31/2025 emails were received from Richard confirming the vessel was being taken care of by One80 Intermediaries which is the insurance company. The insurance company then hired Cooper Capital Specialty Salvage LLC to handle the salvage when it needed to be lifted and recovered from the wet dock at Nature Coast Marina. Richard provided via email a copy of his bank statement, which indicated he received an "E Deposit IN Branch 10/28/24 03:22:53PM" The total amount of this deposit was \$110,895.20 and was the total write off amount from the insurance company for his boat being a total loss. This was sent to his Wells Fargo account based out of Kodiak, Alaska.

Contact was made with Daniel Rutherford, who is the Director of Claims and Risk Management with One80 Intermediaries LLC. He advised Richard Zielinski was paid for the constructive total loss of the vessel (CTL). The salvage was then sold through Cooper Capital. The forwarded me to Cooper Capital Salvage at 8603954745.

Contact was then made with Cooper Capital Salvage on 06/17/2025, who was able to provide the information pertaining to the vessel being auctioned off. The vessel was bought at auction by a subject named;

Cooper Capital Salvage advised the vessel was purchased at auction for \$1999. This is noted in the salvage settlement statement.

motorboat which he purchased from an auction in March. He advised he purchased the boat on March 18th. The vessel was towed from Nature Coast Marina to GPS coordinates 28.1816047 -82.8179220. Jahson visited the vessel on April 4th, 2025. When visiting the vessel at the aforementioned location, on 04/08/2025, at approximately 1800 hours, the vessel was found to not be there. He advised it was possibly lost or stolen. Due to the vessel not being registered in his name, he was unable to file a report with Pasco County Sheriff's Office. Per the Pasco County Sheriff's Office notes (Event # 2025204597) he was in the process of registering the vessel but would be contacting the Sheriff's Office the next day with the documents claiming ownership to the vessel. Jahson dialed to return to the Sheriff's Office with the documents claiming ownership, as he stated to the Pasco Deputy. While speaking with Jahson, he was advised the vessel was located in the area of the Chassahowitzka Bay and was last seen anchored near Channel Marker 13. Jahson advised he would be attempting to locate his vessel on 06/18/2025.

On 06/18/2025 Jahson called the Hernando County Sheriff's Office explaining he laid eyes on his vessel which was found to be "hard beached" in an inlet near Channel Marker 13. This was still within Hernando County's waters. He further explained he felt the vessel was damaged due to subjects boarding it and possibly taking items. This was unable to be confirmed or investigated, due to it not initially being reported as stolen and still being in Richard Zielinski's name. I explained to Jahson the vessel needs to be handled if he is claiming it, in which he stated he has the means to move the vessel and has friends which will be assisting him with this "next week". Which is the week of June 25-June 31. Jahson stated he will be removing the vessel from its location and moving it to the Tampa Bay Area via water.

Documents received for this case will be uploaded to the case in the near future.

### Narrative

On 06/29/2025, I responded to the area of Chassahowitzka and observed the Bertram to be on the south side of the Chassahowitzka Channel in the mangroves. The vessel appeared to be resting on the port side with the bow to be facing in a western direction. It appeared the vessel was pushed into this area during a higher than normal tide. The vessel did not appear to have any obvious holes or damage in the hull keeping it from being afloat.

On 07/03/2025, contact was made with Jahson via phone. He advised he had spent approximately 36 hours working on the vessel since I last spoke to him. He further advised he has more help coming in this week to assist him in moving this large vessel from being in the mangrove area. Jahson advised he is just awaiting a good tide and hoping the weather cooperates with his efforts. Jahson also explained he contained any harmful pollutants on board to the best of his ability.

At this time Jahson is still attempting to remove the vessel from the area. He stated once it is removed from its current position he will be taking it to the Tampa Bay area.

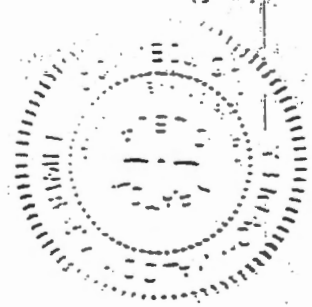

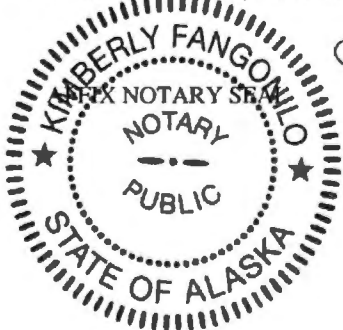
