RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN, OR THE VICE CHAIRMAN, TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY FOR APPROVAL OF THE HERNANDO COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) AND AUTHORIZE LOCAL SHIP REVENUES AS CDBG LEVERAGE, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commission of Hernando County, Florida, in regular session this 12th day of July 2022, as follows:

WHEREAS, Hernando County is experiencing a need for physical improvements to benefit low-to-moderate income households:

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Hernando County, County Commission that:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Community Development Block Grant program is declared to be a workable program for providing needed physical improvements to benefit low-to-moderate income households indicated in the proposed Fiscal Funding Year (FFY) 2020/21 CDBG application.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The County Commission directs the Chairman, or Vice Chair, to sign all necessary certifications of the Community Development Block Grant application.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> The County Commission directs the Chairman, or the Vice Chair, to execute and submit the FFY 2020/21 CDBG application to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (FDEO) for state approval.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> The County Commission authorizes the Chairman, or Vice Chair, to submit additional information in a timely manner as may be required by the FDEO application, award agreement or other State or Federal request related to said application and award agreement.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> The County Commission does hereby commit to spend \$50,000.00 in local SHIP revenues on CDBG eligible activities identified in the Hernando County FFY2020/21 CDBG application as local government leverage in accordance with the applicable rules and guidelines as set forth by the FDEO, subject to grant award.

<u>SECTION 6</u>. The County Commission does hereby commit to expend all local government leverage between the time of site visit and the time of administrative close-out for said application, in accordance with applicable rules and guidelines as set forth by the FDEO.

SECTION 7. The proposed CDBG application is consistent with the local comprehensive plan.

<u>SECTION 8.</u> The County's adopted Comprehensive Plan shall serve as the CDBG Community Development Plan.

SECTION 10. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
