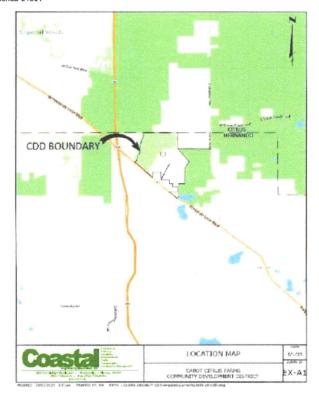

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In compliance with the provisions of Chapter 125 and Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, a public hearing will be held by the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners beginning at 9:00 a.m., or shortly thereafter, on Tuesday, October 7, 2025, in the John Law Ayers County Commission Chambers, 20 North Main Street, Room 160, Brooksville, Florida 34601, to consider an Ordinance to grant a petition to expand the boundaries of the Cabot Community Development District. The title of the proposed Ordinance is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HERNANDO COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2023-14, REVISING THE BOUND-ARIES OF THE CABOT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 190, FLORIDA STATUTES; DESCRIBING THE EXTERNAL BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVER-ABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN ARTICLE II, CHAPTER 10.5, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW.

The Cabot Community Development District is currently comprised of approximately 1206 acres, more or less, generally located in accordance with the location map incorporated herein. The boundary has been revised to add approximately 10.07 acres from the district and remove 330.28 acres, for a net reduction of 320.21 acres from the district. After the boundary has been revised, the district will be comprised of approximately 885.79 acres, more or less.

The District has the authority to plan, finance, acquire, construct, operate and maintain all infrastructure and community facilities, which may be authorized by such districts under Florida law, including but not limited to water management and control, water supply, sewer, wastewater management, bridges or culverts, roads and street lights, parks and recreational facilities, security facilities, and certain other projects when expressly approved or required by a local government and any other facilities in accordance with Section 190.012(1), (2)(a) and (d) and (3), Florida Statutes. The legal description of the expanded boundaries of the Cabot Community Development District shall be as follows:

Any person or affected unit of general-purpose local government, who wishes to appeal any decision made by the Board with respect to any matter considered at this public hearing will need a record of the proceedings. For that purpose, the person or unit of general-purpose local government will need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made that includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
