

**Hernando County Fire and Emergency Services
2023 EMS Billing Rates
Fee Schedule**

Resolution 2023-24

A resolution providing for modifications of the established schedule of fees and charges to be imposed by the Hernando County Fire and Emergency Services; providing that this resolution shall constitute a public record; providing for an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Hernando County Fire and Emergency Services is responsible for providing emergency response to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County desires that a portion of the cost of these services be borne by the users; and

WHEREAS; Hernando County Fire and Emergency Services has determined that modifications are needed to the EMS Billing Rates Fee Schedule; and

WHEREAS; the previous resolutions establishing the schedule of fees and charges are hereby repealed and replaced by this resolution and its attached exhibit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that

Section 1: Schedule of fees and charges

The prior fee schedule is hereby repealed and replaced with the following fees and charges detailed in the exhibit described below and attached hereto:

Section 2: Public Record and Posting

The original of this resolution shall be filed with the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida and the fees and charges and other necessary information shall be posted on the Hernando County Fire and Emergency Services website.

Section 3: Effective Date

The resolution shall take effect on February 15, 2023, once approved, and adopted by the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners and shall remain in effect until such time it is either repealed, amended, or replaced.

• Advanced Life Support 1 Transport Services (A0426) (ALS Unit and Assessment/Scheduled Transport):	\$600.00
• Mileage (per mile):	\$10.00
• Rescue Assist (Services without Transport):	\$75.00
• Wait Time (Per 1/4 hour Increments):	\$204.00
SPECIAL EVENTS:	<u>Hourly Rate</u>
• Dedicated Advanced Life Support Standby (One ALS Ambulance, One Paramedic, One EMT, Three hour Minimum):	\$130.00
• Dedicated Basic Life Support Standby (One BLS Ambulance, Two EMT's, Three hour Minimum):	\$95.00
• Dedicated Paramedic Standby (One Paramedic, Three hour Minimum):	\$46.00
• Dedicated Supervisory Standby (As required, includes operating costs of supervisory vehicle):	\$60.00
