



CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NARRATIVE FOR McCEASE, LLC

<u>Location</u>: This Site is located on the North side of Mondon Hill Road abutting the East side of Cooper Terrace in Hernando County.



EXISTING USE:

This property is currently zoned AG and has been hosting Disc Golf Tournaments for the last 10 years with support from the community. This is a continuation of that which will enhance the County and the community.

PROPOSED USE:

Many Disc Golf Tournaments which will utilize food vendors and beverage vendors to accommodate the players and spectators. Sanitation will be provided by Port-a-potties, and permitted accordingly.

INTENT

The intention of the request for this Conditional Use Permit is for Disc Golf Tournaments with the specific dates as follows:

March 22nd - 24th = Throw Down The Mountain Week #3 March 29th - 31st = Throw Down The Mountain Week #4

The Course during all of March - April 30th will be open to the public during weekdays and then after the final weekend of the Tournament Throw Down The Mountain, the course will be open to the public on the weekends as well until the permit is expired.

Throw Down The Mountain Weekdays - 100-200 people Throw Down The Mountain Weekends - 200-250 people
