The case/event number I was given is #2025204597, attached here is my call logs from the date it was reported stolen. I first called the FWC regional office at 863-648-3200 they did not answer. Because the vessel was anchored in Anclote Anchorage I then called the Tarpon Springs Police Department at 727-938-2849. According to the last known coordinates I provided them they transferred me to Pasco county as it was their jurisdiction. I then informed Pasco county of the situation and provided as many details as possible. I was then contacted by an officer from Pasco County who called me from the phone number 813-997-8447. I gave him as much information as I could and he was very helpful, he called me back 3 more times to update me as he contacted FWC and Coast Guard to inform them of the situation and see if anyone has seen or made contact with the vessel.
