Code Compliance

- **Focus:** Voluntary compliance to rules and requirements.
- **Goal:** To ensure that laws, regulations, standards, and ethical guidelines are followed.
- **Approach:** Often involves proactive measures to establish and maintain conformity.
- **Activities:** Includes actions like developing policies, training employees in collaboration and community engagement.
- **Example:** Using leadership and training to influence citizens to help themselves; therefore solving not only their problem, but a community problem.

Code Enforcement

- **Focus:** Actions taken to compel or ensure adherence to rules when they have been violated.
- **Goal:** To change behavior and deter future violations.
- **Approach:** Often involves reactive measures taken in response to non-compliance.
- **Activities:** Can include inspections, investigations, imposing penalties (fines, sanctions), and initiating legal proceedings.
- **Example:** A regulatory agency imposing fines on a company for failing to comply with environmental regulations.
