

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION NO. 2023-61

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, at its regular meeting of Tuesday, April 11, 2023, adopted Resolution No. 2023-61, declaring that a drought emergency exists in all of the unincorporated areas of Hernando County. Resolution 2023-61 has been adopted to implement Hernando County Ordinance No. 2001-02, which provides for regulation of fire hazards and incendiary devices during drought conditions, such as open burning.

BE FURTHER ADVISED that outdoor burning is prohibited, but that such prohibition shall not be construed to apply to outdoor burning or land clearing where the Division of Forestry has issued a permit. It is unlawful for any person to set fire or cause fire to be set to any forest, grassland, wild land, marshes, vegetation, or land in an urban or rural area including those associated with agriculture, silvaculture, pile burning, or the building of campfires, bonfires, the burning of yard trash, household garbage, refuse, or other debris in the unincorporated areas of Hernando County.

ANY VIOLATION by any person or persons shall be prosecuted and punished according to the terms of the Hernando County Code of Ordinances, Section 12-568, incorporating the penalties provided in Chapter 2, Article III, for a violation of the Hernando County Code of Ordinances.
