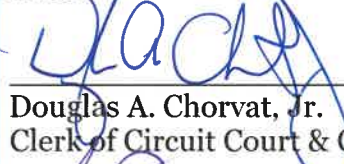
SECTION 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby proclaim May 18-24, 2025, as **PUBLIC WORKS WEEK** in Hernando County.

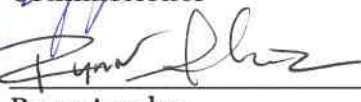

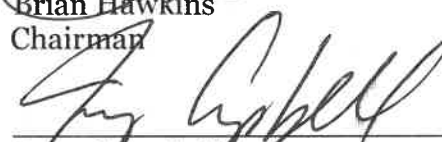
