A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT FOR THE KENSINGTON WOODS STREET LIGHTING MUNICIPAL SERVICE BENEFIT UNIT

WHEREAS, the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to Chapters 125, Florida Statutes and Hernando County Ordinance No. 2023-13, has created a Municipal Service Benefit Unit known as the "**Kensington Woods Street Lighting Municipal Service Benefit Unit**"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, the Tax Collector will include the annual non-ad valorem assessment for the "Kensington Woods Street Lighting Municipal Service Benefit Unit" on the ad valorem tax bill and will use the collection methodology used for ad valorem taxes; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed the comments of interested persons, both spoken and written, concerning this assessment.

SECTION 1. Based on the above and the public hearing held in this matter, the Board of county Commissioners adopts as assessment of \$88.00 per lot for "Kensington Woods Street Lighting Municipal Service Benefit Unit" for Fiscal Year 2025.

SECTION 2. That this assessment will be applied to the assessment roll in preparation for submittal to the Tax Collector prior to September 15, 2024.
