## **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS** HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA **RESOLUTION 2025 - 064** WHEREAS, Florida's future prosperity depends on nurturing the healthy development of over four million children currently living, growing, and learning within our many diverse communities; and WHEREAS, children are the community's greatest asset and should be educated, recognized, cherished, nurtured, and acknowledged as such by all; and WHEREAS, positive childhood experiences like loving caregivers and safe, stable, and nurturing relationships-can help mitigate trauma and the negative impact of adverse childhood experiences (ACES) to promote the social, emotional, and developmental well-being of children; and WHEREAS, childhood trauma can have long-term psychological, emotional, and physical effects throughout an individual's lifetime and impact future generations of their family; and WHEREAS, childhood trauma, including abuse and neglect, is a serious problem affecting every community in the U.S., and finding solutions requires input and action from everyone; and WHEREAS, children who live in families with access to concrete economic and social supports are less likely to experience abuse and neglect; and WHEREAS, the abuse and neglect of children can cause severe, costly, and lifelong problems affecting all of society, including physical and mental health problems, school failure, and criminal behavior; and WHEREAS, research shows that parents and caregivers who have social networks and know how to seek help in times of trouble are more resilient and better able to provide safe environments and nurturing experiences for their children; and WHEREAS, Hernando County has seen an increase in the severity of child abuse cases over the last year, and there were more than 3,203 children in our county who were the subject of child abuse investigations; and WHEREAS, You Thrive Children's Advocacy Center in collaboration with the Hernando County School District, has been providing Monique Burr's Child Safety Matters prevention curriculum in the elementary schools which educates and empowers children and all relevant adults with information and strategies to prevent, recognize, and respond appropriately to all types of abuse, and digital abuse dangers, and Maar. WHEREAS, during the month of April, You Thrive Children's Advocacy Center of Hernando County will be engaging communities throughout Florida in a coordinated effort to prevent child abuse and neglect by promoting awareness of healthy child development, positive parenting practices and the types of concrete support families need within their communities. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF **COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:** SECTION 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby proclaim April 2025 as CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH in Hernando County. SECTION 2. The Board of County Commissioners encourage all residents to engage in activities whose purpose is to strengthen families and communities to provide the optimal environment for healthy child development.
