





RISE CENTER

EMPOWERMENT CENTER AND WAREHOUSE

Empowering the impoverished and marginalized residents of Hernando County and specifically those in South Brooksville with food, healthcare, benefits, and resource connections is crucial for addressing systemic issues of poverty and improving their quality of life. The Rise Center will provide a collaborative venue for the food relief work of the Community Food Bank in conjunction with our partner service providers and organizations.

This community resource center or hub allows individuals to access a variety of support services, including employment assistance, housing resources, childcare, legal aid, and educational programs, it will centralize resources and make them more accessible to those in need.







\$2 MILLION INVESTMENT

CFB is working to acquire a property immediately and then expand our capacity into a new Rise Center and food bank warehouse based in the proposed South Brooksville CRA project. In collaboration with Hernando County, Feeding Tampa Bay, our pantry partners, and our local service/support providers CFB will create a center for food relief, skill building, healthcare, community support, mental health services, and disaster relief.

The Rise Empowerment Center will play a vital role in uplifting this impoverished and marginalized community by providing access to essential services, fostering empowerment through education and skill building, building community and support networks, advocating for systemic change, and promoting holistic well-being.

MICRO-RETAIL INCUBATOR

The micro-retail incubator would provide aspiring entrepreneurs with the resources and support needed to start and grow small businesses.
