The following changes, additions and/or deletions are hereby made a part of the Contract Documents for the above-referenced Solicitation as fully and completely as if the same were fully set forth therein:

A. CLARIFICATIONS

- 1. Addendum 1 Q & A template is nullified.
- 2. List of Permits
 - Commercial Fence Permit
 - Commercial Building Permit
- 3. Exhibit B has been addended to include:
 - Revised site map that shows two required bases for light poles and their location circled in green. The revised site map shows one base marked with a red "x" which is not needed for this project as previously stated in the scope.
 - Design Plans for Overlook and Boardwalk.
 - Spec sheet has been added for the light pole bases.
 - Template for the dimensions of the light pole bases. The contractor will be supplied with the actual template when it is needed.
- 4. A bid item has been added to evaluate the concrete structure for code compliance to be completed by the contractor.
- 5. A bid item has been added for permits.

- 2. <u>Question:</u> Will sand need to be purchased by the Contractor? <u>Answer:</u> No
- Question: Will sand need to be spread by the Contractor?
 Answer: No, the contractor will be responsible for loading, hauling, and unloading sand from Anderson Snow Park to the job location.
- <u>Question</u>: Will the contractor be responsible for moving the pile of sidewalk debris from the work site?
 Answer: No
- 5. <u>Question:</u> What permits are required? <u>Answer:</u> Commercial Fence Permit and Commercial Building Permit
- <u>Question:</u> Will Hernando County provide a survey for the sidewalk locations including any design and permit requirements?
 <u>Answer:</u> Yes, Hernando County will provide an addendum on or around January 3rd, 2024.
- Question: Will the contractor be responsible for installing or running electricity to the light poles for which the concrete bases are being poured?
 Answer: No
- <u>Question:</u> Will Hernando County be responsible for performing independent testing to confirm the quality of the concrete poured onsite? <u>Answer:</u> Yes
- Question: What permits are known to be required at this time?
 Answer: All concrete work, wooden decks and wood ramp will need a Commercial Building Permit. The fencing will require a completed Commercial Fencing Application.
