My Wife and I are writting as concerned residents of Adrian Drive regarding Special Exception Permit application SE-00007-2026 submitted by Yosvany Galindez Brito for the purpose of conducting "Special Events on thier property on Adrian Drive. My Wife and I live directly across the very narrow Adrian Drive.

They have purchased the property recently, and since they have moved in they have had numerous loud parties, events and other types of parties where the noise from loud music, yelling and extra traffic in and out of Adrian Drive has kept us many of nights well into 2AM.

My Wife and I own 8391 Adrian Drive which is about 200 feet from thier property. There are two elderly couples on either side of thier property one being as close as 40 feet from the barn they use as a party house or event center. the other elderly coupke is about 65 feet from the area.

I am a life long resident of Hernando County specifcily to Adrian Drive as I grew up on this road. My elderly Father lives at the end of Adrian Drive. I have lived here for 50 years in the peace and quiet area. Adrian Drive is currently maintained by the long standing residents on this road whch not county maintained.

We ask the Planning Dept. to deny the Special Exception permit to maintain our peace and quiet area. Our concerns are as follows:

1. Adrian Drive is a private single lane non-paved road that our residents maintain ourselves.
2. Increased traffic and road damage will occur.
3. Strian on our infrastructure and emergeny services.
4. Potential for safety and security issues associated with larger groups of non-residents. i.e break-ins increased crime in the area.
5. Noise from live music, large parties, festive activities and people drinking tend to be loud.
6. Disrupting farm animals in the area.

We respectfully request the Planning Dept. to deny this actiion.
