Hernando County plans to apply to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for a FFY 2020 and/or FFY 2021 as needed to receive funding. Housing Category Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) of \$750,000. The County will provide housing rehabilitation to serve approximately eleven (11) homes of low to moderate income households within the unincorporated Hernando County.

Hernando County does not expect that anyone will be displaced as a result of CDBG-funded activities. If any persons are displaced as a result of the planned activities, Hernando County will assist them as described in the County's anti-displacement and relocation policy, which is available for review at **621 West Jefferson Street, Brooksville, FL 34601**.

A public hearing to provide citizens an opportunity to comment on the application will be held at the Hernando County Public Library in downtown Brooksville, near the Courthouse, 238 Howell Avenue, Brooksville, Florida on Thursday June 2, at 6:00 p.m. A draft copy of the application will be available for review at **Health and Human Services, 621 West Jefferson Street, Brooksville, FL 34601 by noon on May 27, 2022**. A final copy of the application will be made available for review during normal business hours in the Health and Human Services Department, 621 West Jefferson Street Brooksville, FL 34601 no later than Friday, July 30, 2022. The application will be submitted to Florida Department of Economic Opportunity or before July 21, 2022.
