- C. Arts in Education Update (Nidia Pierre) - Justin with Storytime is no longer with Library, now Melissa has taken over. They are interested in partnering on workshops taking place in July. and have \$250 budget to pay artists. Library is willing to do print material and promotions. We would have to provide artists, activities, and fund the materials. Question for Cheryl - what was the total check amount written to HCEF? So we know actual budget. **Cheryl confirmed on 2/18 that \$1,500 was spent.**
- D. CAO (Diane Greenwell) - Diane mentioned she may want someone to take over Outreach at some point. This would entail planning events for the Outreach team to set up a booth.
  1. Kass Circle - Not going to set up an Outreach booth, but may attend as a community member and pass out flyers. Diane also mentioned "Togetherhood" group at the YMCA, first year organization.
  2. Mike Nolen brought up two events for potential Outreach
    - a) Sarah at Greenhouse on Main - Early Street Market on first Saturdays, mostly craft & handmade homeopathic goods. Coincides with FPAW
    - b) Broad Street Brewing - Monthly Oddities & Art Market, could look at April or May
  3. Diane said we don't always need to have a booth. You can just go alone or with a group of council members and pass out flyers - and this counts as Outreach!
