ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
HERNANDO COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION, INC.

We, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves together for the forming of an association not for profit for the purpose of conducting and operating public fairs or expositions for the benefit and development of agriculture, horticulture, livestock, and other resources of the State and of Hernando County, Florida, in particular, under the following terms and conditions:

ARTICLE I

The name of this association shall be "HERNANDO COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION, INC.", and its principal office shall be located at Brooksville, Florida.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the objects and powers of this corporation shall be:

- (a) To conduct and carry on fairs and expositions for the purpose of acquainting the public generally with the agricultural, horticultural accomplishments and opportunities of the State of Florida and Hernando County.
- (c) To conduct fairs and expositions of stock and poultry of all kinds, of all manufactured and processed articles, and of farming and agricultural articles or products and all other matters related or pertaining thereto.
- (c) To offer and give prizes in competition in various classifications as might be determined.
- (d) To sponsor, conduct, and carry on expositions in the Florida State Fair at Tampa or any other fair or exhibit conducted outside of Hernando County.
- (e) To carry on and conduct contests between various classifications as might be determined by the Board of Directors to create interest or competition in the raising of livestock of all kinds and in all other farming, agricultural or horticultural pursuits.

(f) To conduct rodeos, horse racing, auto races, and other activities which are desired for the purpose of creating, maintaining, or promoting interest in all lines of agricultural and horticultural pursuits, provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall in any wise be construed as authorizing the maintaining and operation of parimutual betting or other forms of legalized betting at such affairs.

(g) To charge admission to any enterprise which might be carried on, conducted, or sponsored by this association.

(h) To regulate and have control of all applications that might be made for the purpose of exhibits, amusement booths, or other commercial enterprise operated for profit by others other than this association.

ARTICLE III

The qualifications of the members of this association shall be that they shall either be residents and citizens of Hernando County, Florida, or that they be the owners of real property located within Hernando County, Florida, and engaged in or connected with agricultural or horticultural activities within the County. That they shall be elected to membership by the Board of Directors of this association. Provided, however, that the Board of Directors may provide upon such terms as they may determine for ex-officio membership in this association by persons, firms, or corporations not possessing any of the above qualifications. That the period of membership shall be for a period of one year.

ARTICLE IV

That this corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI

The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors to be determined at the annual meeting of the membership hereof and that they shall serve for a period of one year. That the board of Directors shall be composed of such number as the membership hereof may determine, provided that it shall be not less than three nor more than fifteen and that they shall be elected by the membership at each annual meeting thereof. That at least two of the Board of Directors shall be members of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County. That the said board of Directors shall elect from their members a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer, but the office of Secretary and Treasurer may be filled by the same person. That the annual meeting for the election of officers shall be held the first Tuesday in April of each year. That they may also elect an officer to be known as "Manager", who may be a member of the Board of Directors but who need not be a member of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VII

That the names of the officers who are to manage the affairs of this corporation until the first election or appointment under the

charter shall be:

ARTICLE VIII

That the By-laws of this corporation shall be made, altered, or rescinded by the membership at any annual meeting.

ARTICLE IX

That the amount of indebtedness or liability to which it may at any time subject itself shall be the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00).

ARTICLE X

That it may from time to time purchase real or personal property and that any mortgage or indebtedness existing for the unpaid purchase price thereof shall not be included within the Twenty-five Thousand Dollar (\$25,000.00) limitation as provided in the preceding article.

ARTICLE XI

That the Board of Directors may from time to time determine the amount of membership fees or dues to be charged for membership herein or may, at its discretion, provide that no membership fees or dues shall be charged.

SECOND: That a group to be called and known by the name of Hernando County Fair Association, Inc. be, and the same is hereby, now organized and created and that the agreement to incorporate this day presented to this Court signed by Adrian Bell and others shall be adopted as the charter for the said group and that all of the terms and conditions in said agreement be and they are hereby ratified and confirmed in all respects.
