A joint public hearing with the Local Planning Agency and the Board of County Commissioners will be held on March 12, 2024 at 9:00 am in the John Law Ayers County Commission Chambers, Hernando County Government Center, 20 North Main Street, Room 160, Brooksville, Florida.
