Hernando County Emergency Management

Summary of Forecast & Impacts for Hernando County

Forecast:

- Winds
 - Forecasted to receive Tropical Storm force winds (74-110 mph)
- Surge
 - Forecasted up to 3 to 5 feet
- Rainfall
 - Forecasted 2 to 4 inches widespread

Impacts:

- Winds
 - NWS verified Tropical Storm Force wind speed in Hernando County (66 mph)
- Surge
 - No storm surge inundation observed
- Rainfall
 - Less than 3 inches received countywide

Emergency Protective Measures

- Executed Local State of Emergency declaration on the November 9th
- Effective November 7th through November 16th
- Hernando County declared for FEMA Public Assistance Category B
- Sandbag site opened at Linda Pedersen Park

Response Phase Activities

EOC activated to Level 2 (partial activation)

Public Information Center took 78 calls

A total of 82 missions were completed

Next Steps

- Collecting survey responses from all partners to contribute to the development of the After-Action Report
- Determine amount of storm-related expenditures for potential reimbursement
- Continue to follow up on requests for unmet needs assistance as they are received
