A joint public hearing with the Local Planning Agency and the Board of County Commissioners will be held on December 12, 2023, in the John Law Ayers County Commission Chambers, Hernando County Government Center, 20 North Main Street, Room 160, Brooksville, Florida. The meeting starts at 9:00 AM and the amendment will be heard thereafter in the order established when the agenda is published. The Hemando County Board of County Commissioners acting as the Local Planning Agency will review the proposed comprehensive plan amendment for consistency with the comprehensive plan of the region or appropriate local government. The Hemando County Board of County Commissioners proposes to change the use of the land and to adopt the following ordinance:
