GENERAL LOCATION:	East side of Mairdale Road at its northern terminus.

In further support thereof, the BOCC makes the following specific findings of fact:
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:	<ol> <li>The proposed request is consistent with the County's adopted Comprehensive Plan and is compatible with the surrounding land uses.</li> <li>The BOCC is authorized to act on this matter pursuant to Chapters 125 and 163, <i>Florida Statutes</i>. Accordingly, after public hearing and testimony, being fully advised in the record, and based upon competent substantial evidence, the BOCC makes the following specific conclusions of law:</li> </ol>

1. The proposed request is consistent with the County's adopted Comprehensive Plan and is compatible with the surrounding land uses.

Any requests, uses, variances or exceptions that were requested in connection with this rezoning application but not specifically approved herein are hereby deemed DENIED.
