

NOTICE OF REQUESTED TRAFFIC CALMING / VOTE RESPONSE

Dear Property Owner: Key #				
This letter is to inform you of a request made by the Rainbow Woods Homeowners Association to create a Municipal Service Benefit Unit (MSBU) to provide traffic calming measures to Augustine Road and levying an assessment to benefitting property owners.				
To address concerns regarding traffic volumes, speeds, and safety issues on Augustine Road, Traffic Engineering has recommended the implementation of traffic calming measures which include three speed tables and associated signage and pavement marking improvements. Speed tables are an effective and appropriate traffic device for safely reducing vehicle speeds. The speed tables consist of 22-foot long, raised speed humps between 3 and 4 inches in height with a 10-foot flat section in the middle and 6-foot ramps on the ends. The speed table will be clearly marked and visible during the day and night and shall include warning signs on all approaches of traffic. Estimated improvement cost is \$39,250.00 which will be paid solely by the affected property owners.

The recommended methodology for assessing the benefitting properties for the improvement is a per platted lot assessment. There are 168 benefitting lots within the project limits. The budget is based on all lots paying one full assessment. Government owned properties are exempt from the assessment.				
If the traffic calming request meets minimum requirements of property owners (51% of the returned votes) in favor of constructing the improvements, a public hearing will be scheduled to consider adoption of an ordinance creating the Rainbow Woods Traffic Calming MSBU . After construction is completed a second public hearing will take place to adopt a final assessment. You will receive written notification of both hearings.				
Property owners will have the option of paying their assessment in one lump-sum payment or financing their assessment over a two-year period at an <u>estimated interest rate of 6%</u> . Those assessments not paid up-front will automatically be financed and placed on the annual tax bill and collected in the same manner as ad-valorem taxes. As with the ad valorem taxes, failure to pay the assessment will cause a tax certificate to be issued against the property, which may result in a loss of title.
