WHEREAS, mediation is taught and practiced in many of our schools not only as a means of resolving individual disputes, but also as a means of achieving a more peaceful society; and

WHEREAS, community-based mediation programs strengthen relationships among Hernando County's citizens by assisting in the resolution of neighborhood and community conflicts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby proclaim October 16 – 22, 2022 as **MEDIATION WEEK** in Hernando County.


