

Please see the table below. The 7 month Ordinance UTF load and allocation reflects the corrected draft numbers that were recalculated based on Hernando County’s current fertilizer ordinance, as you pointed out in your last email. These are the number we’ll plan to use for the updated BMAP documents.

The 3 month ordinance UTF load and allocation reflects the differences we would anticipate if the county’s ordinance were to change.

A change from a 7 month ordinance to a 3 month ordinance would result in an additional **33,264 pounds of loading attributed to Hernando County** across the three springsheds. With basin reduction percentages considered, this would result in approximately **22,428 additional pounds of reductions allocated to Hernando County**
