





- THERE ARE NO LANE CLOSURES RESTRICTIONS ON THIS PROJECT. HOWEVER, FOR LANE CLOSURES, A WRITTEN PLAN SUBMITTAL IS
 REQUIRED, WHICH DETAILS EACH ACTIVITY INVOLVED IN LANE CLOSURES. THE PLAN MUST INCLUDE BACK-UP PLANS FOR
 ACTIVITIES. NO LANE CLOSURES WILL BE ALLOWED WITHOUT A PLAN TO ACHIEVE RE-OPENING. USE STANDARD PLANS INDEX 102-603

- 4. MOTIFY ALL LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT, EMERGENCY/RESCUE AGENCIES LOCATED IN THE PROJECT VICINITY 24-HOURS IN ADVANCE OF PERFORMING ANY LANE CLOSURES. HERNANDO COUNTY FIRE RESCUE - STATION 6 IS WITHIN THE PROJECT CORRIDOR, ACCESS TO EMERGENCY VEHICLES SHALL BE A PRIORITY DURING ANY LANE CLOSURES.
- 5. TRAFFIC MUST BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES ON SIDE STREETS AND DRIVEWAYS.
- 6. NOTIFY THE ENGINEER AND HERNANDO COUNTY WITHIN A MINIMUM OF 14 DAYS IN ADVANCE OF ANY LANE CLOSURES.
- THE EXISTING POSTED SPEED MUST BE MAINTAINED UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED IN THE PLANS. THE POSTED SPEED IS 50
 MPH APPROACHING JEWFISH DR, 40 MPH JUST SOUTH OF BLUEFISH DR, 45 MPH JUST NORTH OF GULFVIEW DR.

- FOR GENERAL TRAFFIC CONTROL ZONE REQUIREMENTS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION, REFER TO STANDARD PLANS INDEX NO. 102-600. ALL CONSTRUCTION MUST BE COMPLETED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARD PLANS INDEX NO. 102-600 SERIES UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- 12. AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ENGINEER, OPEN ANY TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURE CAUSING EXTENDED TRAFFIC CONGESTION (5-MINUTE DELAY) UNTIL TRAFFIC HAS RETURNED TO AN ACCEPTABLE FLOW AS DETERMINED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 13. CONFLICTING EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS MUST BE REMOVED BY WATER BLASTING ONLY. ALL EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS THAT ARE ALTERED MUST BE REPLACED UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT. THE REPLACEMENT OF MARKINGS MUST BE PAID FOR UNDER THE APPROPRIATE BID ITEM.
- 14. MAINTAIN STREET NAME SIGNS VISIBLE DURING CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS IN ORDER TO FACILITATE EMERGENCY VEHICLE TRAFFIC.
- 15. MAINTAIN BUSINESS ENTRANCES OPEN DURING CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS.
- 16. LIMIT THE LENGTH OF MILLING OPERATIONS TO ASSURE THAT TRAFFIC IS NOT PLACED ON ANY ASPHALT MILLED SURFACE.


