





# Universal Service Expansion

  - Resolution amending the boundaries of the Universal Solid Waste
    Collection District
- Approval of these documents will affect pricing for the RFP for the 2026 collection contract

# Proposed Expansion




## Proposed Map Based Expansion Area




- Area 1: Expands existing boundary to the western Gulf of Mexico border.
- Including, but not limited to,
   Aripeka, Bayport, Hernando
   Beach, Lake in the Woods, Palm
   Grove Colony, Pine Island,
   Regency Oaks, River Country,
   Weeki Wachee Gardens, Weeki
   Wachee Hills, Waters of Weeki
   Wachee and other subdivisions
   and properties within this
   geographic region.
- Estimated 5,531 Homes


## Proposed Map Based Expansion Area



- Area 2: Expands existing boundary east to US 41 and the City of Brooksville limits and north to Fort Dade Ave.
- Hernando Highlands, Deerfield Estates, parts of Masaryktown and Potterfield Gardens, Silver Ridge, Silverthorn, Springwood Estates, Tangerine Estates, Trillum and other subdivisions and properties within this geographic region.
- Estimated 5,739 Homes
