Replacement of County Record System

The most important recommendation:

Replacement of the county record system with a commercially available shelter software program.

Several other recommendations depend on this for reliable, accurate, retrievable, and searchable medical record keeping. Accurate records are essential for measuring shelter performance.

Stay within Capacity for Care

Using minimum practices provided by the ASV Guidelines for Standards of Care in Animal Shelters, which is the industry standard creating. These recommendations include:

- not exceeding the housing capacity for dogs which is 58 dogs;
- upgrade the cat housing to meet the minimum floor space of 8 square feet per cat provided by doublecompartment housing
- not exceeding the housing capacity for cats which is currently 20 cages that meet minimum standards



Population Management Strategies

Stay within the capacity for care for housing dogs and cats depends on effective population management strategies that were detailed in the report, including:

- update the shelter website to feature all pets available for adoption, new admissions of lost pets to facilitate owner reunification, and the volunteers' Instagram posts
- update the shelter Facebook site with engaging pictures, videos, and descriptions of pets
- extend the shelter's hours to be more conducive with public availability to visit the shelter. Consider being open 7 days per week
- recruit more volunteers using an easier on-board process
- recruit more foster homes using an easier on-board process
- establish a population management rounds team to ensure there is an active plan of action for each pet to minimize length of stay
- remove all barriers to adoption or foster placement such as requiring meet and greets for all family members and other pets, requiring proof of landlord permission and home ownership, veterinarian references, adoption applications longer than one page
- add welcoming signage directing the public to the shelter
