a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Hernando County identified the need for a replacement Veterans Monument at the Hernando County Veterans Park located in Spring Hill. The existing monument is located at the entrance of the park and shows signs of deterioration and weathering. The location of the existing monument does not allow for visibility from the multiple athletic fields within the park. This is critical as the National Anthem played during sporting events is done so without appropriate National banners flown in proximity view. Also, the existing monument needs to be updated to include all six military branches of the United States of America.



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b. What activities and services v	II be provided to meet the intended	d purpose of these funds?
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Replacement and relocation of the existing monument (with the addition of the sixth military branch), ADA access to the monument area, as well as sidewalks and benches.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Hernando County can provide both a location for commemoration and place of honor for over 17,791 veterans currently residing in Hernando County and the citizens who appreciate their dedication of service and sacrifice.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Hernando County has over 17,791 veterans currently residing in our County and Veterans Park has thousands of visitors annually.
