ASSIGNMENT OF LEASEHOLD INTEREST

The undersigned authorized representative for the LESSOR, HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, hereby executes this Assignment of Ground Lease based upon the following information:

RECITALS

- 1. On May 1, 1984, the LESSOR, HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, and the LESSEE, KLD PARTNERSHIP, entered into a Ground Lease for the property located at 16150 Aviation Loop, Brooksville, Florida, that was recorded in Hernando County Official Records at Book 552, Page 1988, more specifically described by the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit A. (hereinafter referred to as the "Lease").
- 2. The original term of the Lease was for a period of forty (40) years, with an option by the LESSEE for an additional twenty (20) year term. Further, the LESSEE and LESSOR acknowledge that the option for the additional twenty (20) year term was exercised by the LESSEE on September 29, 2019.
- 3. During the term of the Lease, on October 1, 1998 the KLD Partnership was dissolved by the remaining parties to the Partnership and the Lease was assigned to Mr. Fred J. LeHeup, and his wife, Nita L. LeHeup.
- 4. Mr. Fred J. LeHeup died on July 28, 2006, and as a result of his passing all of the interest in the Lease passed to his spouse, Nita L. LeHeup.
 - 5. Mrs. Nita L. LeHeup died on January 28, 2020.
- 6. Upon September 29, 2020, Randall L. LeHeup was appointed the Personal Representative of the Estate of Nita L. LeHeup by the Circuit Court of Hillsborough County, Florida. See attached copy of Letters of Administration, Exhibit B.
- 7. The Lease is now an asset of the Estate of Nita L. LeHeup and is so listed as part of the inventory of Mrs. LeHeup's Estate Administration, as Mrs. LeHeup prior to her death was the sole successor in interest to the interests of the LESSEE under the Lease.

WHEREFORE, the above paragraphs of the Recital are herein incorporated and acknowledged by the LESSOR and the LESSEE;

WHEREFORE, the LESSOR here by acknowledges that the Estate of Nita L. LeHeup is the successor in interest to the original LESSEE; and

WHEREFORE, the LESSOR hereby shall execute this Assignment pursuant to provisions of Section 9 of the Lease for the purpose of clarifying the current successor in interest to the rights and duties of the LESSEE under the Lease.

All terms and conditions of the Lease are hereby ratified and the duties and responsibilities of the LESSOR and LESSEE to the Lease shall continue on the terms and conditions as provided in the Lease.
