WHEREAS, Tribute to the Troops ® (TTTT) was founded by singer and songwriter Rockie Lynn in 2004, and its mission is to honor, treasure, and remember the sacrifice of the nation's fallen heroes and their families; and

WHEREAS, the Tribute to the Troops Honor Ride on March 15, 2025, to honor and remember, and show their profound appreciation to Lance Corporal Richard Clay Ellis, USMC, and includes a Fallen Service Member Name Reading Ceremony for other Florida Gold Star Families' Fallen Heroes, which will provide the opportunity for the community to honor the Gold Star Families attending, and to let them know their loss will never be forgotten.
